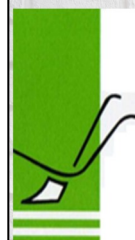

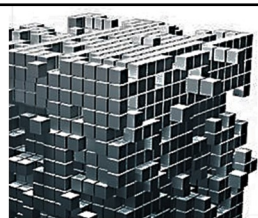

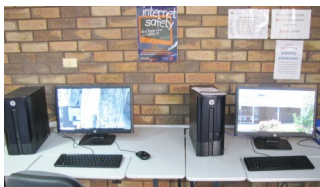

**RECYCLING** Toner cartridges can be RECYCLED at Warracknabeal Neighbourhood House. Every year, Australians throw away millions of printer cartridges or 1400 tonnes into landfill. Each cartridge takes up to 1000 years to decompose. Alternatively cartridges can be recycled into pens, rulers, asphalt or a timber-replacement product, eWoodTM, which is used to make outdoor furniture, fencing, recycling bins and garden beds.

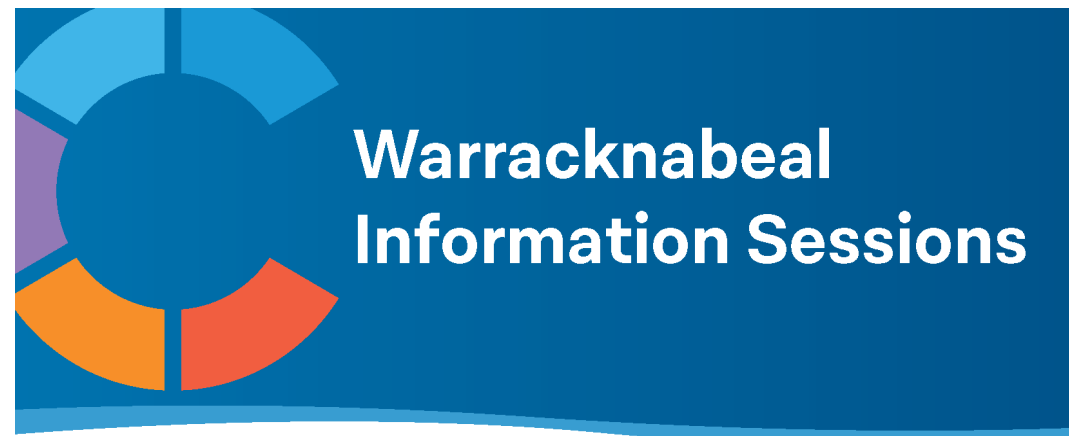
